MEMBERSHIP NOTES AND CLUB RULES

ALL APPLICANTS MUST READ THE SUMMARY OF RULES FOR THE USE OF LOW NORTH PARK SET OUT BELOW AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THEM. INFRINGEMENTS MAY LEAD TO ACTION UP TO AND INCLUDING WITHDRAWAL OF MEMBERSHIP.

TRIALS PRACTICE. Only riders holding a current pass are allowed to use the land. ***Passes must be displayed prominently on the bike at all times.*** It is also advisable to carry membership cards. Random checks will be made and riders without passes will be reported to the committee. Minors must be supervised by an adult member. Members assisting non-members to practice at Low North Park may have their membership of the club terminated.

NO PRACTICE ON DAY OF EVENT. The Permit issued by the ACU for an event is an insurance policy which can be invalidated by the presence of riders who are not signed on as competitors or officials. There can be no practice at Low North Park during an event. Keep an eye on the web-site for news.

THE BOUNDARIES OF LOW NORTH PARK. The boundaries of the club's land are the river on your left and the fence on the right as you enter the main gate; they eventually meet at the far end of the park in the moor. You must not cross these boundaries. We have an agreement to use some of the land over the river for some events, but not at any other time. We are being watched.

THE MOTORCROSS TRACK IS OUT OF BOUNDS AT ALL TIMES. There are designated places to cross the track and members must use these. There is no need to be on the track, it maybe being prepared for an event, please keep off.

SPEED LIMIT ON THE ROADS OF THE PARK. The limit applies to all vehicles including cars and trials bikes. We have a lot of children riding at the Park. They will come out of side roads, car-parks even bushes without warning, they will also keep near the road when it is too muddy for them elsewhere. Nobody wants an accident, please keep your speed right down and watch-out for the little ones at all times.

ENTRY TO THE SITE MUST ONLY BE MADE THROUGH THE MAIN GATE. If you let someone in with your key, it is your responsibility to get them back out again. You may arrive at the gate to find someone waiting to get in. They might be members without a key or they may be waiting for a friend with a key. If you let them in and you have to leave for some reason, trouble with your bike or some other reason, you could spend hours looking for them! It is a big site to find somebody in! They may have gone already! It is best not to let them in at all.

DAMAGE TO CLUB PROPERTY. If you see anybody causing damage at the Park, please take note of who is doing this, take note of vehicle numbers and report them to the committee. Action will be taken with a report to the police when appropriate. Damage to club property costs all of us as repairs and replacements have to be paid for from club funds.

MEMBERSHIP FORM NOTES. Members applying for their first practice pass must attend a committee meeting held monthly on the first Wednesday of each month. Verify time and venue with the secretary or web-site before attending. Applicants will be informed whether their application has been accepted. Please note: applications may be refused without the Club giving the reason for refusal.
